Pool Opening Update 5 (6/3/2020)

Falcon Pointe Residents:

Following up from our last communication dated May 27, 2020. The Board, Pool Committee, Fennell Property Management, and our service vendors have been working to ensure all guidelines and regulations outlined by Knox County Health Department are met. The specific restrictions and guidelines in place, as required by the Knox County Health Department is to maintain social distancing and impede the spread of COVID-19.

- The pool is still on schedule to open on June 15, 2020. It will be the only Monday that the pool is open during the 2020 pool season. The pool will be closed on Mondays for deep clean.
- **ATTENTION:** Residents will receive a packet via U.S. Mail starting later this week.
 - The letter will outline the Online **Registration process to register and activate your key fob.**
 - Also included will be (1) serialized key fob, and a copy of the Pool Complex Rules.
 - Residents must be in good standings and complete the Online Registration/Waiver process before June 15, 2020. Failure to register will result in the non-activation of your key fob.
